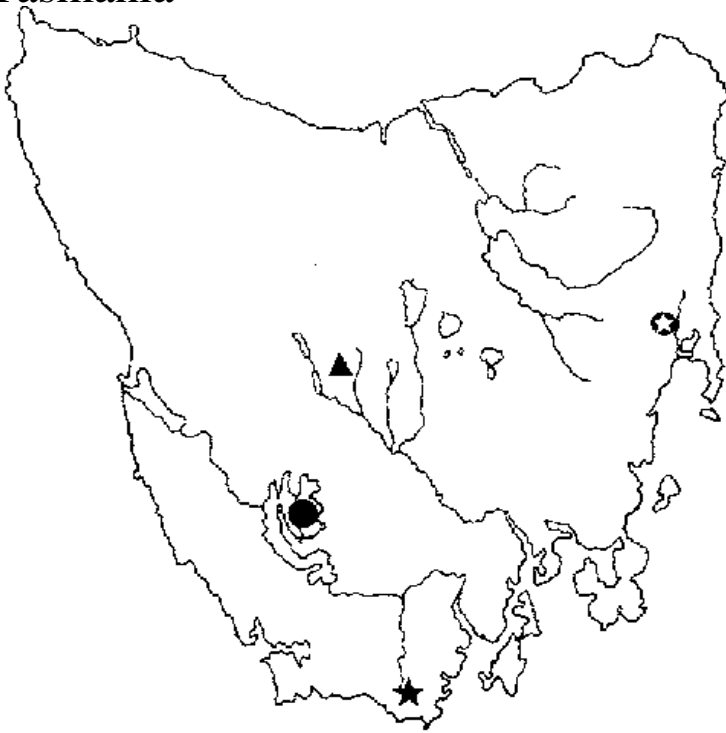


FIG. 1. Map of Tasmania showing the distribution of Galaxias fontanus.
