

National Socialist Literature In Birmingham Reference Library: A Bibliography

Current Bibliography of Urban History

This bibliography is a continuation of that published in UHY 1974. It aims to provide a comprehensive coverage of books published in Britain and listed in the British National Bibliography between 1 August 1973 and 31 July 1974. Wherever possible we have included other English language books although in some cases 1974 publications lack full pagination details as these are not yet available. A large number of periodicals have been scanned and the titles of those from which relevant material has been gleaned are listed in the 'Abbreviations' on pp. 147-9.

Works have been included whenever a reasonable proportion of their content is relevant to urban history. For this reason many general items and county histories have been excluded on the grounds that they were not sufficiently urban in character.

This bibliography is arranged in a classified sequence of ten main subject groups: General, Population, Physical Structure, Social Structure, Economic Activity, Communications, Politics and Administration, Shaping the Urban Environment, Urban Culture, and Attitudes to Cities. Within each group there are subdivisions and within each subdivision items are arranged alphabetically by author. Places of publication other than London are given. To facilitate use of the bibliography an index of towns has been provided.
